Location: Towering Pines Park, Kronenwetter, WI | 2355 Tower Rd, Kronenwetter, WI **Events Offered:** 5K Run/Walk, 10K Run, 1 Mile Kid's Run, 1 Mile Firefighter Challenge

About: Run for the Fallen is a 9/11 memorial run/walk event dedicated to the fallen members of the Port Authority Police Department, New York City Police Department and New York City Fire Department that gave their lives saving others in the attacks on the World Trade Center on September 11th, 2001. Hosted by the Village of Kronenwetter Fire Department, Run for the Fallen provides a supportive, healthy, and family-friendly outlet for fire personnel, law enforcement and the general public looking for a special way to remember 9/11.

Along with t-shirts and promotional items, each participant in a Run for the Fallen event receives a photo ID of one of the 403 first responders who made the ultimate sacrifice that day to run or walk in honor of the day of the event. Every participant is encouraged to look up that individual after the event and learn more about them, keeping our promise to never forget them, their service or supreme sacrifice. In addition to the 5K, 10K and 1 Mile Kid's Run/Walk, Run for the Fallen also includes the 1 Mile Firefighter Challenge. Members from over 40 fire departments from all over the state gather to run or walk 1 Mile in full gear as a tribute to those who gave their lives.

One of the most important parts of Run for the Fallen is the Opening Memorial Ceremony at 8:46AM. This event includes a moment of silence, speeches by National Fallen Firefighters Foundation representatives, Ground Zero volunteers, Wausau Firefighters Honor Guard services, Prayer for the Fallen, live bagpipe performance and National Anthem solo. This powerful part of the day is attended by hundreds of people, coming together to reflect, honor and remember.

With all of our events, we work hard to ensure an extremely supportive and inclusive environment for all those participating. Whether participants have never done an organized run/walk event, or are seasoned athletes, we make sure that they are cheered for at the finish line. We also partner with the organization, myTeam Triumph, who provide a one of a kind experience for athletes with disabilities, by pushing them in specialized strollers so they can share in the experience as well. Run for the Fallen facilities and routes are all handicapped and stroller accessible. Run for the Fallen is also family and dog-friendly.

75% of proceeds benefit the programs of the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation, aiding in line of duty death prevention services for our nation's first responders. The remaining 25% benefit the Village of Kronenwetter Fire Department, aiding in the purchase of gear and equipment needed to serve the Village of Kronenwetter and surrounding communities of Marathon County. From 2015-2019, this event has raised \$61,100.00 for the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation and another \$19,247.00 for the Kronenwetter Fire Department, totaling over \$80,300.00 raised to directly support first responders in our community and beyond.

We spend well over a year planning each Run for the Fallen to ensure that it is expertly coordinated and impeccably organized, making Run for the Fallen the only 9/11 memorial event of its kind in the State of Wisconsin. The cause and dedication of our committee has made this event grow exponentially in a few short years. Run for the Fallen attracts well over 700 participants, nearly 100 volunteers and hundreds of spectators from Wisconsin, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota and beyond.

We have the honor of having the backing and partnerships of over 70 area businesses, assisting us with monetary and in-kind donations and volunteers. Without the incredible support of our community, this event would not be possible. Donations of any size, type, value are always appreciated, but never expected.
